



Rev. Delta McNeish PhD Bio

Delta was born the second child of eight to a well known Lambs River preacher in Jamaica. After living in England for three and a half years, she moved to Canada in 1963. After struggling with many personal issues that halted her endeavours to finish her education she returned to school at the age of 42. The journey of education has resulted in a Doctorate in Christian Counselling at the age of 63. Delta is a Pastor of the British Methodist Episcopal Church in London, Ontario. This is one of the oldest churches in London and was a refuge for run-away slaves in the 1800's.

Delta earned a certificate in Neurobehavioral Rehabilitation Training at Dale Brain Injury Services in 1999 and has been the Facilitator of a Wellness group at the same facility since 2004. She recently received a prestigious award in Human Services for her service to Dale's clientele. Delta is recognized as a General Practice Psychotherapist (GPP) by the Canadian Christian Clinical Counselling Association and has earned Certificates in CISM, and CPC programs. She is Certified as a Marriage Counsellor by the Evangelical Order of Pastoral Counsellors of America.

Delta operates as Heart 2 Heart Counselling Services; a Holy Spirit guided Counselling Service that provides meaningful, wholesome, and life enhancing ministry and walks along-side Counselees helping them to find the keys to alleviate hidden root problems. This is done in an atmosphere of care and confidentiality. As well as individual counselling, Delta also facilitates Group Sessions, Seminars and Workshops

Other achievements also include a CD release in 2004. Scripturally inspired, Delta wrote and sang all titles on "The Spirit and the Bride" while her husband George McNeish assisted with programming, recording, mixing and mastering.

Delta's books "Crisis Identity" was published in 2008 and is an autobiographical account of her emergence from an abusive life to find the answers and celebrate life through the involvement of Holy Spirit. Some of the tools for restoration of life are carefully presented as Models. These models have proven to help those who are struggling.
